

**1AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GREENWICH  
AMENDING CHAPTER 200, SECTION 19 ENTITLED  
CONSUMPTION IN CERTAIN PLACES PROHIBITED**

**ORDINANCE NO. 16 – 2011**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
GREENWICH AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Purpose

Pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 39:4-51a, which addresses consumption of alcoholic beverage by operator or passenger, the Township's Ordinance, Chapter 200, Section 19 titled Consumption in certain places prohibited is appropriate to be amended. Section B of the ordinance is now preempted by State law.

Section 2. Repeal §200-19, Subsection B

Subsection B of Chapter 200, Section 19 is hereby repealed and deleted which stated:

- B. While in a private motor vehicle when the same is in motion or parked in any public street, lane or public parking lot; or

Section 3. Amendment

Section 19 of Chapter 200, Consumption in certain places prohibited is amended to read as follows:

§200-19 Consumption in certain places prohibited.

Any person who shall consume alcoholic beverages while in or on any of the places enumerated below is a disorderly person:

- A. While in or on a public street, lane, sidewalk, public parking lot or other outdoor public place or in any public conveyance; or
- B. While upon any private property not his own without the express permission of the owner or other person having the authority to grant such permission.

Section 4.     Effective:

This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after adoption and publication as required by law.

Introduced at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Township of Greenwich held on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2011 and passed upon a second reading of the Mayor and Council held on the 15th day of August, 2011.
